### OBEDIENCE/RALLY PRACTICE or WARM UP RING NOT OFFERED

See Chapter 2, Section 26 of Obedience Regulations and chapter 2, Section 20 of Rally Regulations.

**Training and Warm-up on the Grounds.** There will be no intensive or abusive training of the dogs on the grounds or premises at an AKC licensed or member obedience trial or sanctioned match. **Collars must be in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 17 of these regulations.** These requirements should not be interpreted as preventing handlers from moving normally about the grounds or premises or from warming up their dogs using any exercise performed in the obedience ring provided the **dog is on a leash being held by the handler.** Warm-ups should be performed as far from the obedience rings as is reasonably possible and must not be disruptive to any dog or person. Physical or verbal disciplining of a dog will not be permitted, except to a reasonable extent in case of an attack on either a dog or a person.

All dogs will be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring, designated warm-up area or exercise area. The superintendent, event secretary and Event Committee members shall be responsible for compliance with this section and shall investigate any reports of infractions.

Changes, Additions or Corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to the close of entries. Telephone changes, additions, corrections received by telephone are not acceptable. Move-ups and Transfers will be accepted for these events but must be received by the trial secretary no later than Wednesday April 3, 2024 if mailed. After that time, hand delivered move-ups or transfers will be accepted until 30 minutes prior to the start of judging each day.

**AKC** assesses recording and event service fees that are included in the entry fee and paid to AKC. Each <u>Obedience</u> entry includes an AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3 for each class in which a dog is entered. See AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2. Each <u>Rally</u> entry includes an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.50 for first class, \$3 each additional class. See AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 4.

**Returned Checks/Declined Transactions** The Event Secretary will add a \$25 service charge for each returned check or declined credit card transaction. Subsequent invalid payments from the same exhibitor may result in being placed on a CASH ONLY basis.

**Refunds** Entry fees will **not** be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally events. If a bitch is withdrawn from such competition because she came into season and trial secretary is notified in writing at least one-half hour prior to the start of the event, the club will refund entries withdrawn under this section. See AKC Obedience Regulations Chapter 1, Section 14 and Rally Regulations Chapter 1 section 13.

- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
