Entry Information

Lure Coursing tests and trials shall be open to eligible breeds one year of age or older. For a complete listing of the breeds eligible to participate in the AKC Lure Coursing program, please visit the AKC website at: www.akc.org/events/lure_coursing/eligible_breeds.cfm. *Breeds italicized in judge assignment tables are not eligible to run for Best in Field.* All eligible dogs must be either individually registered with AKC, recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, or that have been granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL/ILP).

Entry Information -- Day of Entry

- Day-of-trial entries accepted. Entries for test and trial entries close at 7:30 AM the day of the trial. PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD OR CASH ONLY (Exact Change)-NO CHECKS ACCEPTED.
- If entering day-of the trial, **please bring an entry form already filled out** to expedite the check-in process. Entry Form is available online at https://images.akc.org/pdf/LureCoursing_Entry.pdf.

Entry Information -- Online Pre-Entry

- Pre-entry is available at a discounted rate but must be done online via the JotForm link provided and must be paid with a credit card. Pre-entry online entries close Friday 10/9 at noon.
- Each pre-entry form will allow a dog to be entered in the same class for one or both events. A separate e-entry form must be completed for each dog or if the same dog is to be entered in different classes each day (e.g., singles on Sat and Open on Sun).
- If you are entering a QC and the trial on the same day, you must complete a second on-line entry form (e.g., one for QC and one for either an open or single) entry. You also have the option to add another entry the day of the trial, but at the full rate. If you do pre-enter in open stakes and your dog does not pass their QC test, they can run as a single. We can change the class the day of the trial for at no extra charge if they do not pass.
- Your entry and payment will be confirmed by email provided in the entry form. Note that some confirmation emails to Comcast.net email addresses may be lost due to the spam filter on this system. This may also happen with other email addresses. If you enter the incorrect email address this will also cause problems. If you do not receive a confirmation email, it may be in your bulk/junk inbox. If you suspect your form was not correct or received for another reason, please email luretrial@chintiminikennelclub.com.

General Trial Information

1. It is recommended for safety of dogs and handlers, and knowledge of the sport, that all participants should be familiar with the AKC regulations for lure coursing trials and tests, available at this link: [AKC1814-RELURE.pdf](#).
2. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test or trial.
3. Stakes will be split by public random draw if the entry in any one stake is sufficient to hold two or more five-point majors.
4. In the trial, all hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
5. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five (5) minute grace period without refund. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fee for hounds excused, during inspection, for bitches in season, lameness or breed disqualification shall be refunded. Processing fees from Square will be retained for refunds, with the exception of dogs that fail at inspection. Spayed or neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.
6. Electric powered DRAG LURE MACHINES. Lure will consist of white plastic bags.
7. The course will be reversed for the finals.
8. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
9. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive hounds from the trial site.
10. There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose hound not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.
11. NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
12. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
13. Control of dogs is strictly enforced. Dogs must always be on leash except when running.
14. Clean up and carry out all trash. Please pick up all dog feces and remove with trash or put in receptacle provided at site by porta-potties.
15. In accordance to the definition of blankets as set forth by AKC only SOLID BRIGHT color blankets will be allowed on the field. Blankets with patterns, names, or similar embellishments will not be acceptable. Plain piping used to finish seams will be allowed
16. No substitution of entries will be accepted for any reason at these events. Class changes acceptable the day of the trial (e.g., open to singles) only if the secretary is notified prior to the trial and prior to drawing blankets.

TEST AND STAKES OFFERED

JC Test

Open to all hounds of an eligible breed one year or older on the day of the test. (See AKC Lure Coursing Rules and Regulations for any disqualifications that may apply). A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QUALIFIED COURSER CERTIFICATE

Open to a hound at least 12 months of age running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound **SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING THE TESTING HOUND FOR THE QUALIFYING COURSE**. The club will create a QC certificate at the trial for dogs that pass; owners must see secretary to sign form.

IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT EVERY QUALIFYING HOUND HAVE BEEN RUN PREVIOUSLY IN PRACTICE AND THAT TO THE HANDLER'S SATISFACTION RUNS CLEANLY AND KEENLY WITH OTHER HOUNDS.

OPEN

Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or have an American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) qualification certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to AKC. Dogs with ASFA qualification certificates must also provide a copy to be submitted to AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

VETERANS

Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club- 6 years of age; except Afghan = 7 years; Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, and Whippets = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

SPECIALS

Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

SINGLE STAKES

Open to all hound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event.

BEST IN FIELD (BIF) will be offered

Open to all AKC Recognized Breed Best of Breed winners with the exception of FSS breeds.

RIBBONS & PRIZES

JC & QC TEST: Dark green flat ribbon for qualifying score

TRIAL: Ribbons for all placements. Rosettes for Best of Breed and Best In Field. SATURDAY'S & SUNDAY'S Best In Field Award is a large-sized Cedar Creek crate pad.

CKC will award a special rosette to dogs completing a field championship at these trials

- ALL HANDLERS **MUST BE PRESENT** FOR INSPECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS
- Any dog not present for inspection will be considered absent.
- **All dogs will be inspected each day; dogs must be inspected during the times listed below.** QC dogs must be reinspected if they are entered in trial for the same day.
- Field committee and listed volunteers may have dogs inspected early.

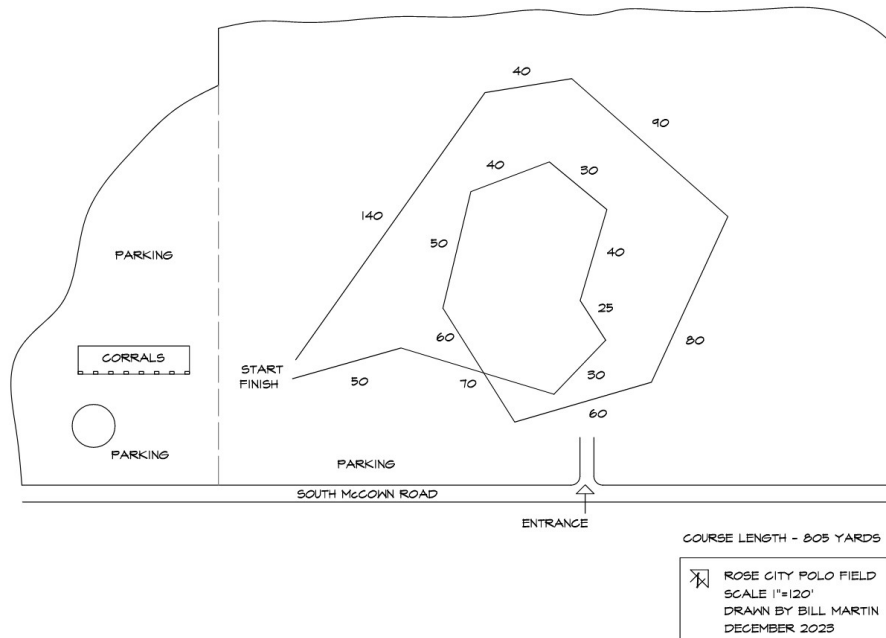

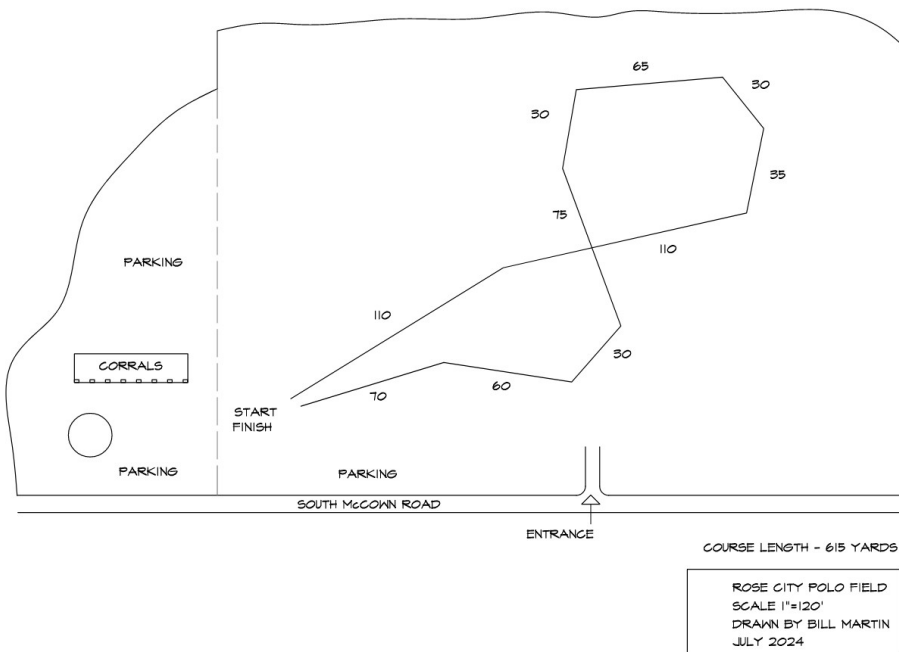

In 1.2 miles turn left onto N Molalla Ave. In 0.3 miles turn right on to S. Vaughan Rd. In 0.3 miles turn left onto S McCown Rd. Look for sign marking entrance to field on the left about 0.3 miles
